Important Notes:

- Please check out the course descriptions with details around the dates, time, and cost of each workshop as several things have changed from last semester. Course cost is between \$45-\$73 depending on the course and supplies.
- **NEW REGISTRATION PROCESS** - We will be using a Google Form for online registration this session.
- **REGISTRATION DATES:** Sept 14 -Sept 19, 2016 - A link will be emailed for registration from the PTO. You can email FunAtFallon1617@gmail.com if you do not receive the form link by 9/15/16.
- **IMPORTANT:** Parents will be notified via email on or before Monday, September 26, if their child has been placed in a class. This email will also include payment instructions. Please do not send payment until you have received an email. Payment is due in FULL by Friday, September 30, to hold the spot. Anyone not submitting payment by this time forfeits his or her spot to the next child on the waiting list.
- Please check dates carefully as classes may be different start and end dates. (Some courses are 7 weeks and some are 8 weeks)
- Whole or partial scholarships are available to students who qualify for a free/reduced lunch. Children who qualify for scholarships may only register for one class. Please email us if you need more information.
- Classes may fill up quickly. To make it fair, we will be using a **lottery system** to select students for classes. We need a minimum of 8 students to open a class.
